Criteria for Center for Leadership Development Scholarship

To be eligible for the Center for Leadership Development Scholarship, students must meet all of the following criteria:

To qualify for the scholarship the student must:

- Satisfy all Center for Leadership Development participant requirements;
- Demonstrate a growing and personal relationship with Jesus Christ;
- Demonstrate strong leadership potential;
- Document participation in various activities that demonstrates an openness to interacting with people whose lives have been shaped by cultures different from their own or other activities that reflect intercultural awareness and/or competence;
- Have a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher and have a combined critical reading and math SAT score of 1050 (ACT composite of 22) or higher;
- Submit a completed Anderson University Application for Admissions and have all required admissions application materials received in the Office of Admissions by January 15th.
- Complete by March 10th the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and authorize Anderson University to receive the results by using our Federal School Code of 001785.
- Submit the CLD Scholarship Application and supporting documents to the Office of Admissions by March 18th. The application and list of requirements can be found online at <http://anderson.edu/admissions>.
- Be admitted and enrolled as a full time student at Anderson University.

On separate sheets of paper, please respond to the following:

1. Submit a list of high school, community, and church involvement along with leadership roles you have had.
2. Respond to the following:
 - Introduce yourself by highlighting one or two significant aspects of your life story which you believe have shaped who you are today.
 - Discuss why you believe it's important to celebrate each other's ethnic heritage and diversity.
 - Tell us about a lesson you have learned about leadership through your high school/community/church experiences. Why do you believe that lesson is valuable?
 - As a potential Massey Scholarship recipient, what knowledge, skills, and attributes will you utilize to engage our community in dialog around racial justice and authentic cultural diversity issues?
 - Anderson University strives to graduate students with a global perspective who are interculturally competent. What does this mean to you? What would happen in your tenure as a student to ensure that we have accomplished that with you?
3. Include two letters of recommendation from people who can speak to the following:
 - Academic Achievement
 - Christian Commitment
 - Leadership Qualities
 - Church and/or Community Involvement(These may be included with the rest of your application or mailed separately.)
