While we do our best to honor special housing requests, we do not guarantee that you will be placed with a specific type of student. Our student leaders are trained to make your visit a positive one; therefore, the more time you can spend with your host, the better.
- You will be informed of where you are staying and with whom when you arrive on campus.
- If you are staying overnight AFTER you have participated in an Individual Visit, Discovery Day or Department Discovery, please proceed to the Welcome Center at 4:00 p.m. to meet your student leader. (unless otherwise noted).
- If you are staying overnight BEFORE you participate in any visit activities, you should go directly to the Welcome Center/ Office of Admissions when you arrive on campus.
- If you are staying overnight as part of a campus-scheduled event, please refer to check-in information specific to that event, as overnight registration will vary based upon each event.
- You will need to bring a sleeping bag, a pillow, and any personal items, such as toiletries and towels.

As a courtesy to our staff and student volunteers, please inform the Office of Admissions of any changes in your plans. If you need to cancel your housing reservation, you may do so by calling our toll-free number, (800) 428-6414.

- Visiting students may not leave campus unless you are with your parents or legal guardian. If you leave
 campus without parental supervision, your Cruiser host will contact the Cruiser Student Manager who will
 contact your parents, and you will be asked to leave.
- Once you check in with your Cruiser host, you are expected to stay on campus with your host. If you plan
 to spend most of your visit with family or friends, we ask that you do not make overnight arrangements with
 the Office of Admissions.
- You are expected to show care and respect for your host's/hostess' dorm room and everything therein.
- Please use careful judgment in safeguarding your possessions. Anderson University is not responsible for any lost or stolen property.
