

Accounting Major (68 credit hours)

The Accounting major is designed to provide a knowledge base in both financial and managerial accounting. Accounting courses expose the student to a broad perspective of accounting needed for management responsibility within a company, in the field of public accounting, and for studies in a graduate program. The major provides coursework that helps prepare students for the Certified Public Accountant (CPA) exam.

Recommended:

- ACCT 4860, Practicum in CMA Exam Preparation, 1-2 credit hours

The State of Indiana requires 150 credit hours to sit for the CPA examination. An additional 28-30 course hours are required beyond this suggested sequence. Students planning to sit for the exam in a state other than Indiana are responsible for verifying the requirements in that state.

NOTE: All students must complete 120 total credit hours to graduate from Anderson University.
