

International Relations Major (42-43 credit hours)

The International Relations major is an innovative opportunity for AU students to tailor their studies to fit our rapidly changing world. This major was designed for students desiring to be better prepared to work in the global environment, whether they actually work beyond the United States or within its borders.

Major Requirements:

- Foundational courses (16 credit hours) from:
 - POSC 2020, Introduction to Politics 3 credit hours
 - POSC 2200, Public Policy, 3 credit hours
 - POSC 2400, Political Science Research Methods, 3 credit hours
 - POSC 2580, Principles of Geography, 3 credit hours
 - ECON 2010, Macroeconomics, 3 credit hours
- Advanced courses (6 credit hours) from:
 - POSC 3300, International Security, 3 credit hours
 - POSC 3510, International Policy Economy, 3 credit hours
- Modern Foreign Language courses taken at collegiate level (11-12 credit hours) from one of the following options:
 - Three from SPAN 2010, 2020, 3010, 3020, 3101, 3102, 3103, 3104, 3110, 3140, 3200, or 3240, courses must be above number used to fulfill the language requirement of the Liberal Arts Curriculum
 - Critical language courses taken at institutions or programs approved by the department
