Position: Tenure-Track, Assistant Professor, Exercise Science

Department: School of Nursing and Kinesiology

Responsibilities:

Anderson University is seeking candidates for Full-time faculty appointment (Tenured Track) at Anderson University beginning in August, 2020. This position involves teaching in the exercise science program in the areas of research methods, resistance training and conditioning, biomechanics, advanced exercise physiology, and the supervision of clinical experiences. Part of the teaching load could include program director. Salary is competitive, and Anderson University offers a supportive and dynamic working environment.

Qualifications:

Doctorate in Exercise Science is preferred or master degree required. Doctoral degree to be completed within a negotiated period of time, in Exercise Physiology, Kinesiology or a related field, prior previous college teaching experience is desirable. American College of Sports Medicine (ACSM) and/or the National Strength and Conditioning Association (NSCA) certification is preferred. A positive attitude and desire to work in a “team” atmosphere are essential for this position.
