Applications are being accepted for a full-time, tenure-track position in Finance. The Anderson University Falls School of Business invites applicants who are interested in joining an ACBSP accredited program that emphasizes excellence in teaching. Beginning in August 2020, the position will be filled by an energetic individual who will join a business school that currently includes 14 full-time faculty who share a vision to develop leaders with Christian values and solid business expertise.

Qualifications:

The ideal candidate will have doctoral qualifications, practical experience, and strong teaching skills. ABDs near completion or candidates willing to earn a doctorate will be considered. Teaching load may include courses in corporate finance, investing, portfolio management, and principles of finance. The teaching load will be in both the undergraduate and MBA program. An opportunity to work with doctoral students is available. Preference will be given to candidates with strong practical and teaching experience in finance and those that hold an industry certification (CFA, CMA, CFP, CIMA). ABD's or promising applicants willing to earn a doctorate degree in finance or finance related fields will be considered.
