Responsibilities: Anderson University Athletics will add esports in the 2020-21 academic year. Esports coaching experience, collegiate varsity or club-level, preferred. Expert knowledge of League of Legends, Rocket League and/or CS:GO. Knowledge of NACE and related organization's rules and regulations.
