

Measure 3: Candidate Competency at Completion

This set of data aligns to CAEP Annual Report Measure 3: Candidate Competency at Completion (Component R3.3).

Candidates are evaluated at the end of their student teaching experience using the proprietary RISE (*Research-based Inclusive System of Evaluation*) rubric. The table below represents RISE category mean scores for the 2022-23 student teachers. The range of scores possible is 1 to 4. Higher scores equate to higher levels of effectiveness as determined by the assigned mentor teacher and university supervisor. The 2022-23 student teachers have mean scores at 3.0 or above on all criteria, indicating a high degree of confidence that these program completers have the knowledge, skills, and dispositions necessary to enter the teaching profession.
