This set of data aligns to CAEP Annual Report Measure 3: Candidate Competency at Completion (*Component R3.3*).

Candidates are evaluated at the end of their student teaching experience using a summative assessment aligned to the InTASC standards. The table below represents category mean scores for the 2023-2024 student teachers. The range of scores possible is 1 to 4. Higher scores equate to higher levels of effectiveness as determined by the assigned mentor teacher and university supervisor. The 2023-2024 student teachers have mean scores at 3.24 or above on all criteria, indicating a high degree of confidence that these program completers have the knowledge, skills, and dispositions necessary to enter the teaching profession.
