

Accounting Major (68 credit hours)

The Accounting major is designed to provide a knowledge base in both financial and managerial accounting. Accounting courses expose the student to a broad perspective of accounting needed for management responsibility within a company, in the field of public accounting, and for studies in a graduate program. The major provides coursework that helps prepare students for the Certified Public Accountant (CPA) exam.

- ACCT 4850, Practicum in CPA Exam Preparation, 1-4 credit hours is highly recommended for students planning on sitting for the CPA Exam, but not required for the major.

The State of Indiana requires 150 credit hours to sit for the CPA examination. An additional 28-30 course

hours are required beyond this suggested sequence. Students planning to sit for the exam in a state other than Indiana are responsible for verifying the requirements in that state.

NOTE: All students must complete 120 total credit hours to graduate from Anderson University.
