Position: Assistant Football Coach - Offense

Responsibilities:

The assistant football coach will work directly with other members of the coaching staff, particularly the head coach, on the development, implementation and organization of goals and outcomes that are in accordance with institutional, conference and NCAA guidelines. Responsibilities include coaching, recruitment and retention of academically qualified student-athletes. Secondary duties as assigned.

Qualifications: The successful candidate will have a minimum of a bachelor's degree (required); a master's degree is preferred. Also required are previous coaching experience (collegiate preferred); a clear understanding of NCAA III philosophy and the student-athlete experience; ability to recruit in Indiana and contiguous states; ability to work as a part of a team environment; a demonstrated commitment to the Anderson University mission and Christian lifestyle. Must demonstrate the ability to communicate with a diverse student body, faculty and staff; effective problem-solving skills and personal initiative.

Benefits: This is an 83% FTE academic year position (August to May). Benefits eligible position.
