Responsibilities:

Qualifications: The successful candidate must have a minimum of a Bachelor's degree, Master's preferred. Background in strength and conditioning and performance enhancement. NATA/BOC certified, CPR/AED certified, CSCS or PES preferred, but not required. Candidate must be willing to pursue this certification. Must be willing to supervise and teach athletic training students. Ability to work as part of a team environment. Candidates must demonstrate a commitment to and ability to work with a diverse student population. An understanding of and commitment to the mission of a Christian college is required. Must meet university lifestyle expectations.
