

International Relations Major (42-43 credit hours)

The International Relations major is designed to transform students with an interest in or concern for international affairs into graduates who can understand, evaluate, manage, and shape political events and governmental actions in a manner consistent with a Christian faith perspective. The major involves the study of the international political system and processes to explain outcomes and policies that promote peace and justice. Graduates will be prepared for successful careers in government, politics, law, non-profits, teaching, journalism, business, and more.

- MATH 2120, Introductory Statistics with Applications, 4 credit hours (fulfills Quantitative Reasoning)

- POSC 3510, International Political Economy, 3 credit hours
