English Language Arts Teaching Major (44 credit hours in English and 43 credit hours of Secondary Education Requirements through the Education Department)

The English language arts teaching major is designed to prepare the student for teaching in grades 5-12. It includes a 38-hour core of courses with English and speech captions, thus qualifying the student to teach English and speech courses in grades 5-12, and 6 additional hours of advanced writing.
