

Music Business: (53 credit hours)

The music business major prepares students for a career in one of the following **EARS** tracks: **Entrepreneurship**, **Audio Forensics**, **Record production**, and **Songwriting**. This major requires completion of courses in music, music performance, music business, and business. Students must complete an internship in music business, tailoring an in-depth experience in their chosen music industry track.
