Scholar's Fair: Scientific Presentation Outline

Below is a sample outline for your scientific presentation. Each presentation should be submitted as a PowerPoint file. It should include approximately 10 slides. You will have a maximum of 10 minutes for your presentation regardless of how many slides you have prepared. Ideally you will take 8-9 minutes for your presentation and respond to questions for 1-2 minutes.

- 1. Title
- 2. Abstract
- 3. Question, Variables, & Hypothesis
- 4. Background research
- 5. Materials list
- 6. Experimental procedure
- 7. Data analysis and discussion (including data tables and graphs)
- 8. Conclusions
- 9. Acknowledgements
- 10. Works Cited

The purpose of your scientific presentation is to describe the scientific project you have completed. See the evaluation rubric for all required items with descriptions. In addition to containing key information in your presentation, you should also be prepared to answer questions about your project. All presentations will be evaluated by college-level instructors.
