**Summer School 2023 (May 15 - August 18)**  
**(Registration for summer school begins February 20, 2023)**

**1. Format for summer offerings**

The summer courses fall into one of three time frames:

May 15 - June 30 (7 week session)

July 3 - August 18 (7 week session)

May 15 - August 18 (14 week session)

**2. How to register for summer classes**

\* Meet with your advisor to decide what classes you should take;

\* Talk to your Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships counselor to decide if you will use a student loan for summer courses or pay out of pocket;

\*Once you have met with your advisor and Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships counselor, you can enroll through AccessAU for 12 credit hours or less (with SFS approval) between the dates of February 20 - Apr 28;

\*You do not need to enroll through the Registrar's office unless you are enrolling after Apr 29 or for more than 12 credit hours;

\*Dropping a class or adding additional hours will require approval of Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships.

**3. Don't see a course you are interested in?**

Individual reading courses may be arranged with the permission of the instructor. Talk to your advisor or the department that usually offers the course you are interested in.

**4. Cost for summer 2023**

The cost for summer 2023 courses is \$399 per credit hour, in line with the cost at other four-year institutions (both private and state) in Indiana. If you have questions regarding tuition or fees, contact the Business Office.

In order to obtain a full refund for courses dropped, contact must be made prior to the scheduled first day of class.

Registration constitutes a contractual agreement between the university and the student. Students withdrawing after a class has begun may be entitled to a reduction in tuition charges. Adjustments are based upon the date of official withdrawal. The official date of withdrawal will be the date the contact is made by e-mail.
